SCHOOL OF PHARMACY. (a) The board may 7 establish and maintain a school of pharmacy as a professional 8 9 school of the health science center. (b) The board may prescribe courses leading to customary 10 degrees offered at other leading American schools of pharmacy and 11 12 may award those degrees. (c) If available facilities for the school of pharmacy at 13 14 the health science center become insufficient to operate the school, the board may locate any facility necessary for the 15 permanent operation of the school of pharmacy on land owned by the 16 system for establishing the University of North Texas at Dallas or, 17

18 if that university has been established, at the university.

19 SECTION 2. Not later than August 31, 2004, the Texas Higher 20 Education Coordinating Board shall prepare an impact statement 21 examining the initial implementation of this Act and shall deliver 22 a copy of the statement to the board of regents of the University of 23 North Texas System and to the chair of the standing committee of 24 each house of the legislature with primary jurisdiction over higher
