5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 28.002(f), Education Code, is amended to

- 8 (f) In addition to courses in the required curriculum, a [A]
- 9 school district may offer courses for local credit, including an
- 10 internship program in which a student works with an elected local,
- 11 state, or national government official [in addition to those in the
- 12 required curriculum]. The State Board of Education shall be
- 13 flexible in approving a course for credit for high school
- 14 graduation under this subsection.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
