BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

Section 28.002(f), Education Code, is amended to SECTION 1. read as follows:

(f)In addition to courses in the required curriculum, a [A]school district may offer courses for local credit, including an internship program in which a student works with an elected local, state, or national government official [in addition to those in the required curriculum]. The State Board of Education shall be flowible in approximate the state of the sta flexible in approving a course for credit for high school graduation under this subsection.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

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
