A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

Τ	AN ACT
2	relating to regulation of casket sales.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subtitle L, Title 3, Occupations Code, is
5	amended by adding Chapter 652 to read as follows:
6	CHAPTER 652. REGULATION OF CASKET SALES
7	Sec. 652.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
8	(1) "Casket retailer" means a person who sells a
9	casket at retail in this state or offers a casket for retail sale in
10	this state.
11	(2) "Commission" means the Texas Funeral Service
12	Commission.
13	(3) "Retail casket establishment" means a place of
14	business or any other place in which a person engages in, or
15	represents the person to be engaged in, the business of retail
16	casket sales.
17	Sec. 652.002. PROHIBITED PRACTICES. (a) A casket retailer
18	may not:
19	(1) represent that the person is a funeral director,
20	embalmer, or other person licensed under Chapter 651 unless the
21	person holds a license under that chapter;
22	(2) provide funeral directing services unless the
23	person holds a funeral director's license under Chapter 651;

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(3) use false, deceptive, or misleading advertising or

- 1 use, in connection with an advertisement, the name of a person who
- 2 is falsely represented to be a licensed funeral director or
- 3 licensed funeral establishment;
- 4 (4) solicit business or offer an inducement to secure
- or attempt to secure business for the casket retailer under a permit
- 6 issued under Chapter 154, Finance Code;
- 7 (5) take custody of human remains; or
- 8 <u>(6) engage in fraudulent, unprofessional, or</u>
- 9 deceptive conduct in providing funeral merchandise to a customer.
- 10 <u>(b) A casket retailer may not restrict, hinder, or attempt</u>
- 11 to restrict or hinder:
- 12 (1) the advertisement or disclosure of prices and
- 13 other information regarding the availability of funeral services
- 14 and funeral merchandise that is not unfair or deceptive to
- consumers; or
- 16 (2) an agreement for funeral services between a
- 17 customer and a licensed funeral director or embalmer.
- 18 (c) A casket retailer may not use a statement that misleads
- or deceives the public, including a false or misleading statement
- 20 regarding:
- 21 (1) a legal, religious, or cemetery requirement for
- 22 funeral merchandise or funeral, cemetery, or crematory services;
- 23 (2) the preservative qualities of funeral merchandise
- 24 or funeral, cemetery, or crematory services in preventing or
- 25 substantially delaying the natural decomposition of human remains;
- 26 (3) the airtight or watertight properties of a casket
- 27 or outer enclosure; or

- 1 (4) the licenses or registrations held by the
- 2 personnel in the operation of a cemetery, crematory, funeral
- 3 establishment, or retail casket establishment.
- 4 Sec. 652.003. CASKET DISPLAY. (a) A casket retailer shall
- 5 provide a display of caskets with sufficient merchandise to allow
- 6 customers a reasonable selection.
- 7 (b) A display must include at least five adult caskets, two
- 8 of which must be full-size.
- 9 (c) The least expensive casket displayed must be a full-size
- 10 casket displayed in the same manner as the other full-size caskets
- 11 are displayed.
- 12 Sec. 652.004. PUBLIC INTEREST INFORMATION. On written
- 13 request the commission shall provide to a casket retailer copies of
- 14 the brochure prepared by the commission under Section 651.201. A
- 15 casket retailer shall print additional copies of the brochure if
- 16 the commission is unable to provide a sufficient number of
- 17 brochures.
- 18 Sec. 652.005. RETAIL PRICE LIST; PURCHASE AGREEMENT. (a) A
- 19 casket retailer shall provide:
- 20 (1) a retail price list to each person who inquires in
- 21 person about the prices of the goods and services offered by the
- 22 <u>retailer; and</u>
- (2) a purchase agreement to each person who purchases
- 24 goods or services from the retailer.
- 25 (b) A retail price list must include:
- 26 (1) the name, address, and telephone number of the
- 27 retail casket establishment;

1	(2) the effective date of the price list; and
2	(3) the following printed notice: "The goods and
3	services below are those we can legally provide to our customers.
4	You may choose only the items you desire. If you need funeral
5	directing services, please consult a licensed funeral director."
6	(c) A purchase agreement must include:
7	(1) the name, address, and telephone number of the
8	<pre>retail casket establishment;</pre>
9	(2) the name, mailing address, and telephone number of
10	the consumer protection division of the attorney general's office;
11	(3) a statement informing the person that complaints
12	may be directed to the consumer protection division of the attorney
13	<pre>general's office;</pre>
14	(4) the signature of the casket retailer; and
15	(5) the following printed notice: "The goods and
16	services listed below are those we can legally provide to our
17	customers. You may choose only the items you desire. If you need
18	funeral directing services, please consult a licensed funeral
19	director."
20	(d) A casket retailer shall provide in a timely manner
21	general information related to the goods and services offered by
22	the retailer and the prices of the goods and services to a person
23	who requests the information by telephone.
24	Sec. 652.006. RECORDS. (a) A casket retailer shall retain
25	copies of all price lists and purchase agreements required by
26	Section 652.005 until the second anniversary of the effective date
27	of a price list or of the date an agreement is signed.

- 1 (b) A casket retailer shall make the records retained under
- 2 <u>Subsection (a) available to the attorney general on request.</u>
- 3 Sec. 652.007. CIVIL PENALTY. (a) A person who violates
- 4 this chapter is subject to a civil penalty of not more than \$1,000
- 5 for each violation.
- 6 (b) The attorney general may bring an action to recover the
- 7 <u>civil penalty.</u>
- 8 <u>(c) A penalty recovered under this section shall be</u>
- 9 deposited to the credit of the general revenue fund.
- SECTION 2. Section 651.201(a), Occupations Code, is amended
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 (a) The commission shall prepare a brochure with
- 13 information of public interest:
- 14 (1) explaining matters relating to funerals; [and]
- 15 (2) describing:
- 16 (A) the functions of the commission; and
- 17 (B) the commission's procedures for filing and
- 18 resolving a public complaint; and
- 19 <u>(3) explaining the right of a customer to purchase a</u>
- 20 casket from a third-party casket retailer without being charged an
- 21 additional fee by the funeral establishment.
- SECTION 3. (a) Not later than March 1, 2004, the Texas
- 23 Funeral Service Commission shall examine the public information
- 24 brochure provided under Section 651.201, Occupations Code, and
- 25 develop a new brochure to include the additional information
- 26 required by Section 651.201(a), Occupations Code, as amended by
- 27 this Act, and other information the commission considers

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- 1 appropriate.
- 2 (b) Notwithstanding Section 651.201, Occupations Code, as
- 3 amended by this Act, a brochure distributed by the Texas Funeral
- 4 Service Commission, a funeral director, a funeral establishment, a
- 5 casket retail establishment, or a casket retailer is not required
- 6 to contain the information required by that section, as amended by
- 7 this Act, before September 1, 2004.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
