A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to sales tax information provided by the comptroller to 3 certain municipalities. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Sections 321.3022(a) and (f), Tax Code, 5 are amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) The comptroller on request shall provide to a municipality that has adopted a tax under this chapter and that has 8 a population of not more than 275,000 information relating to the 9 amount of tax paid to the municipality under this chapter during the 10 11 preceding or current calendar year by each person doing business in 12 the municipality who annually remits to the comptroller state and 13 local sales tax payments [of more than \$100,000]. 14 (f) Information received by a municipality under this

15 section is confidential $\underline{and}[\tau]$ is not open to public inspection[τ 16 \underline{and} may be used only for the purpose of economic forecasting or for 17 \underline{the} purpose described in Subsection (g)].

18 SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect immediately if it 19 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each 20 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. 21 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate 22 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

(b) The change in law made by this Act applies only to a
request for information made on or after the effective date of this

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1 Act. The change in law made by this Act does not affect a request 2 for information made before the effective date of this Act or the 3 use of that information, without regard to whether the comptroller 4 furnishes the information requested before, on, or after that date.

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
