- 2 relating to the annexation of additional territory and the
- 3 composition of the port commission of the Port of Corpus Christi
- 4 Authority of Nueces County, Texas.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS. In this Act:
- 7 (1) "Authority" means the Port of Corpus Christi
- 8 Authority of Nueces County, Texas.
- 9 (2) "Commissioners court" means the Commissioners
- 10 Court of San Patricio County.
- 11 (3) "Port commission" means the port commission of the
- 12 Port of Corpus Christi Authority of Nueces County, Texas.
- 13 SECTION 2. CONFIRMATION ELECTION. (a) As soon as
- 14 practicable after the effective date of this Act, the commissioners
- 15 court shall hold an election in San Patricio County to allow for
- 16 voting for or against the proposition: "Annexation of San Patricio
- 17 County to the Port of Corpus Christi Authority of Nueces County,
- 18 Texas."
- 19 (b) The commissioners court shall conduct the election as
- 20 provided by Sections 62.296 and 62.298, Water Code, performing all
- 21 the duties of the commission of the annexing district provided by
- 22 those sections.
- (c) The commissioners court shall canvass the returns of the
- 24 election and certify the election result to the port commission.

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- 1 (d) If a majority of the voters voting at the election favor
- 2 the annexation of San Patricio County, the port commission shall
- 3 enter and record an order of annexation as provided by Sections
- 4 62.299(c) and (d), Water Code.
- 5 (e) Section 41.001, Election Code, does not apply to an
- 6 election held under this section. Except as provided by this
- 7 section, the confirmation election must be conducted as provided by
- 8 the Election Code.
- 9 SECTION 3. EXPIRATION DATE. If the annexation of San
- 10 Patricio County is not approved at an election held under Section 2
- of this Act before September 1, 2004, this Act expired on that date.
- 12 SECTION 4. PORT COMMISSION. If the annexation of San
- 13 Patricio County is approved at an election held under Section 2 of
- 14 this Act:
- 15 (1) the port commission is composed of seven members;
- 16 (2) notwithstanding Section 2, Chapter 397, Acts of
- the 68th Legislature, Regular Session, 1983:
- 18 (A) the Commissioners Court of Nueces County
- 19 shall appoint three members to the port commission;
- 20 (B) the City Council of Corpus Christi shall
- 21 appoint three members to the port commission;
- 22 (C) the Commissioners Court of San Patricio
- 23 County shall appoint one member to the port commission;
- (D) in Nueces County and San Patricio County
- 25 there shall not be a residential requirement for appointment to the
- 26 port commission; and
- 27 (E) all port commissioners shall have full

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- 1 financial disclosure that shall be filed annually with the County
- of Nueces and the County of San Patricio
- 3 (3) the commissioners serving at the time the
- 4 annexation of San Patricio County is approved continue to serve,
- 5 unless otherwise removed as provided by law, until the expiration
- 6 of their terms;
- 7 (4) after the initial term of the new commissioner,
- 8 all of the commissioners shall serve staggered three-year terms, as
- 9 provided by Section 3, Chapter 397, Acts of the 68th Legislature,
- 10 Regular Session, 1983, with the terms of three commissioners
- 11 expiring every year.
- 12 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
