- 4 (4) any postsecondary education options;

- 8 availability of age-appropriate instructional environments;
- 9 (8) independent living goals and objectives; and
- 10 (9) appropriate circumstances for referring a student
- or the student's parents to a governmental agency for services.
- 12 SECTION 2. Sections 29.011(b)-(e), Education Code, are 13 repealed.
- SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2003-2004
- 15 school year.
- 16 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
