Section 42.0442 of the Human Resources Code is 4 5 amended to read as follows: The department shall coordinate monitoring inspections 6 (a) of licensed day-care centers, licensed group day-care homes, and 7 registered family homes performed by another state agency or 8 political subdivision of the state to 9 eliminate redundant inspections. 10 The department shall form an interagency task force with 11 (b) 12 the Texas Department of Health, the Texas Department of Human 13 Services, and the Texas Workforce Commission to develop an inspection protocol that will coordinate inspections by those 14 The protocol must assign the required items for 15 agencies. inspection by each agency and facilitate the sharing of inspection 16 data and compliance history. 17 force 18 (c) The interagency task shall establish an inspection checklist based on the inspection protocol developed 19 under Subsection (b). Each state agency that inspects a facility 20 21 listed in Subsection (a) shall use the inspection checklist in 22 performing an inspection. A state agency shall make a copy of the completed inspection checklist available to the facility at the 23 facility's request to assist the facility in maintaining records. 24

(d) The department shall provide to facilities listed in
Subsection (a) information regarding inspections, including who
may inspect a facility and the purpose of each type of inspection.
SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
