Section 108.003, Family Code, is amended by 17 adding subsection (c) to read as follows: 18 (c) CORRECTIONS OF BUREAU OF VITAL STATISTICS FORMS. Forms 19 submitted to the Bureau of Vital Statistics shall be mailed 20 21 directly from the Bureau of Vital Statistics to the attorney of 22 record as designated on the Bureau of Vital Statistics form.
