- 4 SECTION 1. Section 508.051, Government Code, is amended to

- 6 Sec. 508.051. SUNSET PROVISION. The Board of Pardons and
- 7 Paroles is subject to review under Chapter 325 (Texas Sunset Act),
- 8 but is not abolished under that chapter. The board shall be
- 9 reviewed during the period in which agencies are reviewed in
- 10 anticipation of legislative action by the 80th Legislature, Regular
- 11 Session, 2007 [the Texas Department of Criminal Justice is

- SECTION 2. Section 508.141(c), Government Code, is amended
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 (c) Before releasing an inmate on parole, a parole panel
- shall interview the inmate and may have the inmate appear in person
- 17 before the panel [and interview the inmate].
- 18 SECTION 3. Section 508.223, Government Code, is amended to
- 19 read as follows:
- Sec. 508.223. PSYCHOLOGICAL COUNSELING. A parole panel
- 21 shall [may] require as a condition of parole or mandatory
- 22 supervision that a releasee serving a sentence for an offense under
- 23 Section 42.072, Penal Code, attend psychological counseling
- 24 sessions of a type and for a duration as specified by the parole
