Savings in utility cost from 16 one department may be used to finance capital expenditures in other 17 18 departments provided the expenditures are part of a through a contract for energy conservatiion measures to reduce energy or 19 water consumption or operating costs of governmental facilities 20 21 that guarantees utility savings. (c) An agency shall provide the Legislative Budget Board 22 23 with justification for any capital expenditures that are not part
