14	more than 36,000 that borders the Red River by a governmental entity
15	or representative.
16	(b) The newspaper in which a notice is published under this
17	section must:
18	(1) devote not less than 20 percent of its total column

20	(2) be published at least once each week;
21	(3) be entered as second-class postal matter in the

- 1 (4) have been published regularly and continuously for 2 at least 12 months before the governmental entity or representative 3 publishes notice.
- (c) A weekly newspaper has been published regularly and continuously under Subsection (b) if the newspaper omits not more than two issues in the 12-month period.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
