12	NOTICE. (a) In a county with a population of at least 30,000 and
13	not more than 45,000, the newspaper in which a notice is published
14	<u>must:</u>
15	(1) devote not less than 20 percent of its total column
16	lineage to general interest items;
17	(2) be published at least once each week;
18	(3) be entered as second-class postal matter in the
19	county where published or have a mailed circulation of at least 51
20	percent of the homes within the county; and
21	(4) have been published regularly and continuously for
22	at least 12 months before the governmental entity or representative
23	publishes notice.
24	(b) A weekly newspaper has been published regularly and

<u>continuously under Subsection (a) if the newspaper omits not more</u> <u>than two issues in the 12-month period.</u> <u>SECTION 3.</u> This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
