## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Subsection 231.131(a), Local Government Code is amended as follows:
- 6 (a) The legislature finds that:
- 7 (1) the areas that surround Lake Alan Henry, Lake
- 8 Cooper, Lake Ralph Hall, and Post Lake are or will be frequented for
- 9 recreational purposes by residents from every part of the state;
- 10 (2) orderly development and use of the area is of
- 11 concern to the entire state; and
- 12 (3) buildings in the area that will be frequented for
- 13 resort or recreational purposes will tend to become congested and
- 14 to be used in ways that interfere with the proper use of the area as
- 15 a place of recreation to the detriment of the public health, safety,
- 16 morals, and general welfare.
- 17 SECTION 2. Subsection 231.132(a), Local Government Code is
- 18 amended as follows:
- 19 (a) This subchapter applies to:
- 20 (1) those parts of Garza County located within one
- 21 mile of the high water marks established for Lake Alan Henry and
- 22 Post Lake except land located in Garza County and owned by the White
- 23 River Municipal Water District;
- 24 (2) those parts of Kent County located within one mile

- of the high water marks established for Lake Alan Henry; and
- 2 (3) the area within 10,000 feet of where the shoreline
- 3 of Lake Cooper would be if the lake were filled to its storage
- 4 capacity.
- 5 (4) the area within 5,000 feet of where the shoreline
- 6 of Lake Ralph Hall would be if the lake were filled to its storage
- 7 capacity.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
