- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 391.098, Transportation Code, is amended
- 7 by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 8 (d) In this section, "director" means the director or the
- 9 director's designee.
- SECTION 2. Section 391.091, Transportation Code, is amended
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 391.091. ERECTION AND MAINTENANCE OF SIGNS. (a) The
- 13 department [commission] shall contract with an individual, firm,
- 14 group, or association in this state to erect and maintain specific
- 15 information logo signs, major shopping area guide signs, and major
- 16 agricultural interest signs at appropriate locations along an
- 17 eligible highway.
- 18 (b) The department may enter into a contract under this
- 19 section by the method that the department determines is the most
- 20 practical or most advantageous for the state, including competitive
- 21 bids, competitive sealed proposals, and open market contracts.
- (c) The department shall make a written award of a contract
- 23 to the offeror whose proposal offers the best value for the state.
- 24 In determining the best value for the state, the department may

- consider:

- 2 (1) revenue provided to the department by the
- 3 <u>contractor;</u>
- 4 (2) fees to be charged eligible businesses or
- 5 agricultural interests for inclusion on the signs;
- 6 (3) the quality of services offered;
- 7 (4) the contractor's financial resources and ability
- 8 to perform; and
- 9 (5) any other factor the department considers
- 10 <u>relevant.</u>
- 11 (d) To the extent of any conflict, this section prevails
- 12 over any other law relating to the method of the purchasing of goods
- 13 and services by the department.
- 14 (e) Subtitle D, Title 10, Government Code, and Chapter 223
- do not apply to purchases of goods and services under this section.
- SECTION 3. Section 201.112(a), Transportation Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 (a) The commission may by rule establish procedures for the
- 19 informal resolution of a claim arising out of a contract described
- 20 by:
- 21 (1) Section 22.018;
- 22 (2) Chapter 223; [<del>or</del>]
- 23 (3) Chapter 2254, Government Code; or
- 24 (4) Section 391.091.
- 25 SECTION 4. Sections 391.097(b) and (c), Transportation
- 26 Code, are repealed.
- 27 SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act applies only

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- 1 to a contract entered into by the Texas Department of
- 2 Transportation on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 3 contract entered into by the Texas Transportation Commission before
- 4 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed
- 5 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former
- 6 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 7 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
