## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to certain procedures involving the use of ballots for

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 84.032, Election Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 7 <u>(e) A request for cancellation in a manner other than as</u>
- 8 authorized by this section, including a request by letter, has no
- 9 effect.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 86.004, Election Code, is amended to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 86.004. TIME FOR PROVIDING BALLOT TO VOTER. The
- 13 balloting materials for voting by mail shall be mailed to a voter
- 14 entitled to vote by mail not later than the seventh calendar day
- 15 after the later of the date the clerk accepts the voter's
- application for a ballot to be voted by mail or the date [voters as
- 17 soon as practicable after] the ballots become available for
- 18 <u>mailing</u>, except that if that mailing date is [but not] earlier than
- 19 the 45th day before election day, the balloting materials shall be
- 20 mailed not later than the 38th day before election day.
- 21 SECTION 3. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 22 (b) The change in law made by this Act to Section 86.004,
- 23 Election Code, applies only to an application to vote an early
- voting ballot by mail submitted for an election that is ordered on

1 or after the effective date of this Act.
