4	SECTION 1. Section 841.002(8), Health and Safety Code, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	(8) "Sexually violent offense" means:
7	(A) an offense under Section 21.11(a)(1),
8	22.011, or 22.021, Penal Code;
9	(B) an offense under Section 20.04(a)(4), Penal
10	Code, if the defendant committed the offense with the intent to
11	violate or abuse the victim sexually;
12	(C) an offense under Section 30.02, Penal Code,
13	if the offense is punishable under Subsection (d) of that section
14	and the defendant committed the offense with the intent to commit an
15	offense listed in Paragraph (A) or (B);
16	(D) an attempt, conspiracy, or solicitation, as
17	defined by Chapter 15, Penal Code, to commit an offense listed in
18	Paragraph (A), (B), [or (C), or (G);
19	(E) an offense under prior state law that
20	contains elements substantially similar to the elements of an

federal law, or the Uniform Code of Military Justice that contains

elements substantially similar to the elements of an offense listed

(F) an offense under the law of another state,

offense listed in Paragraph (A), (B), (C), [or (G);
