A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to the implementation of a project for reintegration of 3 offenders into the labor force.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 306.005, Labor Code, is amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 Sec. 306.005. MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING--CONTENTS. (a)
- 8 The memorandum of understanding between the department and the
- 9 commission must establish the role of:
- 10 (1) the institutional division and the state jail
- 11 division in ascertaining and encouraging an inmate's chances for
- 12 employment by:

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- 13 (A) providing vocational and educational
- 14 assessment for the person while incarcerated;
- 15 (B) developing a skills enhancement program for
- 16 the person while incarcerated, in cooperation with other
- 17 governmental, educational, and private entities, using available
- public or private financial resources authorized by statute; [and]
- 19 (C) referring the person on release to the
- 20 project through the person's parole officer or supervision officer;
- 21 and
- (D) assigning to the person a licensed social
- worker employed under Section 501.098 or 507.033, Government Code,
- to coordinate with applicable local workforce development boards to

- 1 encourage and monitor the progress of the person with respect to the
- 2 project;
- 3 (2) the community justice assistance division and the
- 4 pardons and paroles division of the department in:
- 5 (A) encouraging and referring persons to the
- 6 project; and
- 7 (B) ensuring that those persons participate in
- 8 the project and avail themselves of its services; and
- 9 (3) the commission in developing and maintaining a
- 10 statewide network for finding positions of employment that require
- 11 the skills possessed by project participants and in helping those
- 12 participants to secure employment.
- 13 (b) The memorandum of understanding between the Texas Youth
- 14 Commission and the commission must establish the roles of the
- 15 institutional and community services division in the Texas Youth
- 16 Commission and the role of the commission in the same manner the
- 17 roles of the department and commission are established under
- 18 Subsection (a), except that the Texas Youth Commission is not
- 19 required to employ or assign a licensed social worker as described
- 20 by Subsection (a)(1)(D).
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 306.007(a), Labor Code, is amended to
- 22 read as follows:
- 23 (a) To assist in the reintegration into the labor force of
- 24 persons formerly sentenced to the institutional division or the
- 25 state jail division, the commission through Project RIO shall
- 26 provide:
- 27 (1) to those persons:

- 1 (A) information from local workforce development
- 2 boards on job training and employment referral services;
- 3 (B) information from the Texas Commission on
- 4 Alcohol and Drug Abuse on substance abuse treatment services;
- 5 (C) information from the Texas Department of
- 6 Housing and Community Affairs on housing services;
- 7 (D) information from the Texas Veterans
- 8 Commission on services for veterans; [and]
- 9 (E) information from the Texas Department of
- 10 Human Services on tax refund voucher programs under Subchapter D,
- 11 Chapter 31, Human Resources Code; and
- 12 <u>(F) other information associated with a</u>
- 13 successful reintegration of those persons into the labor force,
- 14 including information regarding counseling and spiritual resources
- available in the community; and
- 16 (2) to the employers and potential employers of those
- 17 persons:
- 18 (A) information from the Texas Department of
- 19 Economic Development [Commerce] on the enterprise zone program and
- 20 smart jobs fund program; and
- 21 (B) information from local workforce development
- 22 boards on services listed in Section 2308.304, Government Code.
- SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 501, Government Code, is
- 24 amended by adding Section 501.098 to read as follows:
- Sec. 501.098. LICENSED SOCIAL WORKERS PARTICIPATING IN
- 26 PROJECT RIO. The institutional division shall employ a sufficient
- 27 number of social workers licensed under Chapter 505, Occupations

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- 1 Code, to participate in the project for reintegration of offenders
- 2 into the labor force as described by Chapter 306, Labor Code.
- 3 SECTION 4. Subchapter B, Chapter 507, Government Code, is
- 4 amended by adding Section 507.033 to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 507.033. LICENSED SOCIAL WORKERS PARTICIPATING IN
- 6 PROJECT RIO. The state jail division shall employ a sufficient
- 7 number of social workers licensed under Chapter 505, Occupations
- 8 Code, to participate in the project for reintegration of offenders
- 9 into the labor force as described by Chapter 306, Labor Code.
- 10 SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 11 to a person who is discharged or released from confinement or
- imprisonment on or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 6. This Act takes effect January 1, 2004.
