4	SECTION 1. Chapter 30, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 30.006 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 30.006. WAIVER OF RIGHT TO DEMAND JURY TRIAL.
7	written agreement in which a person waives the person's right to
8	demand a jury trial must contain the following statement in bold,
9	underlined, capitalized, 16-point type:
10	"BY ENTERING INTO THIS AGREEMENT YOU ARE WAIVING YOUR RIGHT
11	TO DEMAND A JURY TRIAL. THE LAW DOES NOT REQUIRE THAT YOU WAIVE THIS
12	RIGHT."
13	SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a written agreement
14	entered into on or after the effective date of this Act. A written
15	agreement entered into before the effective date of this Act is
16	governed by the law in effect immediately before that date, and that
17	law is continued in effect for that purpose.
