3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 251, Transportation Code,
5	is amended by adding Section 251.018 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 251.018. ASSESSMENT FOR STREET IMPROVEMENT. (a) The
7	commissioners court of a county may assess a landowner for the cost
8	of improving a public highway, street, or alley abutting the
9	owner's land. The assessment may not exceed the amount by which the
10	improvement specially benefits the owner's abutting land by
11	enhancing the land's value.
12	(b) The commissioners court of a county may issue assignable
13	certificates for the payment of the assessed cost.
14	(c) The assessment creates a lien on the owner's abutting
15	land for the assessed cost.

- (d) Regardless of Subsection (a), a railway company shall
- 17 pay the cost of a street improvement made between the rails or
- 18 tracks of the company or made in the area extending two feet from a
- 19 <u>rail or track of the company.</u>
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
