- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 503.038(c), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) A person whose general distinguishing number is
- 8 canceled under this chapter shall surrender to a representative of
- 9 the department each license, license plate, temporary cardboard
- 10 tag, sticker, and receipt issued under this chapter not later than
- 11 the 10th day after the date the general distinguishing number is
- 12 canceled. The department shall direct any peace officer to secure
- 13 and return to the department any plate, tag, sticker, or receipt of
- 14 a person who does not comply with this subsection.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 503.061, Transportation Code, is amended
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 503.061. DEALER'S LICENSE PLATES. (a) Instead of
- 18 registering under Chapter 502 a vehicle that the dealer owns,
- operates, or permits to be operated on a public street or highway,
- 20 the dealer may apply for, receive, and attach metal dealer's
- 21 license plates to the vehicle if it is the type of vehicle:
- 22 (1) that the dealer sells; and
- 23 (2) for which the dealer has been issued a general
- 24 distinguishing number.

- 1 (b) The board may adopt rules regulating the issuance and
- 2 use of a license plate issued pursuant to the terms of this section.
- 3 SECTION 3. Section 503.066(d), Transportation Code, is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 (d) A <u>metal</u> license plate issued under this <u>chapter</u>
- 6 [section] expires on the same date as the expiration of the dealer
- 7 license to which it is issued [March 31 of the year after the year of
- 8 issuance, unless provided otherwise by law or rule of the
- 9 department's Motor Vehicle Board].
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
