3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 201, Transportation Code,
5	is amended by adding Section 201.6011 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 201.6011. TEXAS-MEXICO BORDER TRADE CORRIDOR PLAN.
7	The department shall implement an integrated trade transportation
8	corridor plan for cross-border traffic. The plan must:
9	(1) include strategies and projects to aid the
10	exchange of international trade using the system of multiple
11	transportation modes in this state; and
12	(2) assign priorities based on the amount of
13	international trade, measured by weight and value, using the
14	transportation systems of this state, including:
15	(A) border ports of entry;
16	(B) commercial ports;
17	(C) inland ports;
18	(D) highways;
19	(E) pipelines;
20	(F) railroads; and
21	(G) deepwater gulf ports.
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
