- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 206.210(a), Occupations Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (a) A surgical assistant license expires on the second
- 7 anniversary of the date of issuance. The medical board by rule
- 8 shall provide for the [annual] renewal of a surgical assistant
- 9 license.
- 10 SECTION 2. Subchapter F, Chapter 206, Occupations Code, is
- amended by adding Section 206.2525 to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 206.2525. REIMBURSEMENT FOR SERVICES. (a) This
- 13 chapter does not limit the way in which a surgical assistant
- 14 licensed under this chapter may be reimbursed for services.
- 15 (b) A surgical assistant licensed under this chapter may
- directly bill a patient or third-party payor for services provided
- 17 by the surgical assistant.
