- 11 distributor, provider, or another entity engaged in a

- (b) Acceptance of a gift or grant under this section is
- 14 subject to the written approval of the commissioner. Chapter 575
- does not apply to a gift or grant under this section.
- 16 (c) The commissioner may adopt rules and procedures to
- implement this section. The rules must ensure that acceptance of a
- 18 gift or grant under this section is consistent with any applicable
- 19 federal law or regulation and does not adversely affect federal

- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
