## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the rates of certain retail public utilities.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. (a) Section 10.08(a), Chapter 966, Acts of the
- 5 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (a) The changes in law made by this article to Chapter 13,
- 8 Water Code, apply to a proceeding in which the Texas Natural
- 9 Resource Conservation Commission has not issued a final order
- 10 before the effective date of this article [; provided, however,
- 11 that this article does not apply to a retail public utility for
- 12 which a final order in any rate proceeding has been issued by the
- 13 Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission prior to January 1,
- 14 2001, as long as that retail public utility is the same as,
- 15 controlled by, or an affiliate of the retail public utility for
- 16 which a final order was issued prior to January 1, 2001. This
- 17 subsection shall not be construed to permit a public utility to
- 18 increase rates without obtaining the approval of the Texas Natural
- 19 Resource Conservation Commission].
- 20 (b) The change in law made by this Act is a clarification of
- 21 existing law and does not imply that existing law may be construed
- 22 as being inconsistent with the law as amended by this Act.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
