5 SECTION 1. Amend Section 16.012, Water Code by adding a new

6 Subsection (n) to read as follows:

7 (n) Information collected by the executive administrator 8 for use in the development of groundwater availability models under

9 <u>subsection (1) of this section that reveals site-specific landowner</u>

information is not subject to Chapter 552, Government Code, and may

11 <u>not be disclosed to any person, provided that the landowner has</u>

12 requested that such information be deemed confidential. The

executive administrator or his designee shall advise the landowner

of the right to request that information be deemed confidential

under this subsection at the time that the permission is requested from the landowner to conduct groundwater studies or surveys on the

17 landowner's property. If a landowner requests that his or her

information not be disclosed, the executive administrator may

19 release information regarding groundwater information only if the

information is summarized in a manner that prevents the

21 <u>identification of an individual or specific parcel of land and the</u>

22 landowner. This subsection does not apply to a parcel of land that

23 is publicly owned.
