A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the lease of space for state agencies by the Texas
3	Building and Procurement Commission.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 2167.001, Government Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	Sec. 2167.001. APPLICABILITY. (a) This chapter applies
8	to:
9	(1) office space;
10	(2) warehouse space;
11	(3) laboratory space;
12	(4) storage space exceeding 1,000 gross square feet;
13	[and]
14	(5) boat storage space;
15	(6) aircraft hangar space;
16	(7) vehicle parking space; and
17	(8) a combination of those kinds of space.
18	(b) This chapter does not apply to:
19	(1) [aircraft hangar space;
20	[(2)] radio antenna space;
21	(2) [(3) boat storage space;
22	[(4) vehicle parking space;
23	$\left[\frac{(5)}{(5)}\right]$ residential space for a Texas Department of
24	Mental Health and Mental Retardation program;

- 1 (3) [(6)] residential space for a Texas Youth
- 2 Commission program;
- 3 (4) $\left[\frac{(7)}{(7)}\right]$ space to be used for less than one month for
- 4 meetings, conferences, conventions, seminars, displays,
- 5 examinations, auctions, or similar purposes;
- (5) (8) district office space for members of the
- 7 legislature;
- 8 (6) [(9)] space used by the Texas Workforce
- 9 [Employment] Commission;
- 10 $\underline{(7)}$ [$\frac{(10)}{(10)}$] residential property acquired by the Texas
- 11 Department of Housing and Community Affairs or the Texas State
- 12 Affordable Housing Corporation that is offered for sale or rental
- 13 to individuals and families of low or very low income or families of
- 14 moderate income; or
- 15 (8) [(11)] except as provided by Section 2167.007,
- 16 classroom and instructional space for an institution of higher
- 17 education.
- SECTION 2. Section 2167.005, Government Code, is amended by
- 19 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 20 (d) The commission may revoke a delegation of authority made
- 21 under this section.
- SECTION 3. Section 2167.007(c), Government Code, is amended
- 23 to read as follows:
- (c) The commission may [shall] establish a system of charges
- 25 and billings to assure the recovery of the cost of providing
- 26 services under Subsection (a) and may [shall] submit, after the
- 27 close of each month, a purchase voucher or journal voucher to an

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- 1 agency for which services were provided.
- 2 SECTION 4. Section 2167.054(d), Government Code, is amended
- 3 to read as follows:
- 4 (d) As provided in a request for proposals and under rules
- 5 adopted by the commission, the commission may discuss acceptable or
- 6 potentially acceptable proposals with offerors to assess an
- 7 offeror's ability to meet the solicitation requirements and to
- 8 obtain the most advantageous lease contract for the state. The
- 9 commission may [shall] invite a leasing state agency to participate
- 10 in discussions and negotiations conducted under this section.
- 11 After receiving a proposal but before making an award, the
- 12 commission may permit the offeror to revise the proposal to obtain
- 13 the best final proposal.
- SECTION 5. Sections 2167.055(d) and (f), Government Code,
- 15 are amended to read as follows:
- 16 (d) A lease contract that does not contain an option to
- 17 renew may, on agreement of the parties, be renewed under terms to
- 18 which all parties to the contract agree [once under the provisions
- of the original contract for a term that does not exceed one year].
- 20 (f) The obligation of the lessor to provide lease space and
- of the commission to accept the space is binding on the <u>execution of</u>
- 22 <u>the lease</u> [award of the] contract.
- SECTION 6. Section 2167.101, Government Code, is amended to
- 24 read as follows:
- Sec. 2167.101. CERTIFICATION OF AVAILABLE MONEY. A state
- 26 agency occupying space leased under this chapter shall certify to
- the commission, at least 60 days before the beginning of each fiscal

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- 1 biennium during the lease term, that money is available to pay for
- 2 the lease until the end of the next fiscal biennium.
- 3 SECTION 7. The following laws are repealed:
- 4 (1) Section 2167.003(c), Government Code;
- 5 (2) Section 2167.004(b), Government Code; and
- 6 (3) Section 2167.106, Government Code.
- 7 SECTION 8. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 8 (b) A lease contract entered into by the Texas Building and
- 9 Procurement Commission before September 1, 2003, under Chapter
- 10 2167, Government Code, is governed during the remaining term of the
- 11 lease by Chapter 2167, Government Code, as it existed immediately
- 12 before September 1, 2003, and the prior law is continued in effect
- 13 for this purpose. Chapter 2167, Government Code, as amended by this
- 14 Act, applies to the renewal of a lease described by this subsection.
