- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 34.002(a), Education Code, is amended to

- operation of a school bus for the transportation of schoolchildren

- (b) In adopting rules under this section, the department

1 (2) long-range, maintenance-free factors.

SECTION 3. Rules that were adopted under Section 547.7015,
Transportation Code, before the effective date of this Act and that
are in effect on the effective date of this Act are continued in
effect as rules of the Department of Public Safety until the rules
are amended, repealed, or superseded by an action of the
department.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
