H.B. No. 3042

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the administration of the Texas Building and
3 Procurement Commission.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 2152.058(b), Government Code, is amended
6 to read as follows:

7 (b) The commission shall meet at least quarterly [~~once each~~
8 ~~month~~]. The commission may meet at other times at the call of the
9 presiding officer or as provided by the commission's rules.

10 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 2152, Government Code, is
11 amended by adding Section 2152.065 to read as follows:

12 Sec. 2152.065. REPRESENTATION ON BOARD OR COMMITTEE. If the
13 commission must be represented on a board or committee, the
14 executive director or the executive director's designee shall serve
15 as the commission's representative on the board or committee unless
16 the presiding officer of the commission elects to personally serve
17 as the commission's representative or appoints a specific person to
18 serve as the commission's representative on the board or committee.

19 SECTION 3. Sections 2152.104(a) and (d), Government Code,
20 are amended to read as follows:

21 (a) The commission shall have an appropriate number of
22 [~~three~~] associate deputy directors.

23 (d) In accordance with this subchapter, the executive
24 director shall appoint a director of facilities construction and

1 space management, who shall[+]

2 ~~[(1) be a registered architect or registered~~
3 ~~professional engineer, and~~

4 ~~[(2)]~~ have proven administrative ability and
5 experience in the fields of building design and construction.

6 SECTION 4. Section 2172.001(a), Government Code, is amended
7 to read as follows:

8 ~~[(a)]~~ The commission may ~~[shall]~~ operate a central supply
9 store at which only state agencies, the legislature, and
10 legislative agencies may obtain small supply items. If the
11 commission operates a central supply store the commission shall
12 devise an appropriate method of billing a using entity for the
13 supplies.

14 SECTION 5. Section 2172.002(a), Government Code, is amended
15 to read as follows:

16 (a) The commission may ~~[shall]~~ maintain a facility for
17 repairing office machines and may ~~[shall]~~ offer repair services to
18 the following entities located in Austin:

- 19 (1) state agencies;
20 (2) the legislature; and
21 (3) legislative agencies.

22 SECTION 6. Section 2172.001(b), Government Code, is
23 repealed.

24 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

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1 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
