A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to travel services contracts.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Sections 2171.052(b) and (c), Government Code, 5 are amended to read as follows:

6 (b) The central travel office may [shall] negotiate 7 contracts with private travel agents, with travel and transportation providers, and with credit card companies that 8 provide travel services and other benefits to the state. 9 The central travel office may [shall] negotiate with commercial lodging 10 11 establishments to obtain the most cost-effective rates possible for 12 state employees traveling on state business.

13 (c) The commission <u>may</u> [shall] make contracts with travel 14 agents that meet certain reasonable requirements prescribed by the 15 central travel office, [allowing contracts to provide travel 16 services by as many private travel agents as possible] with 17 preference given to resident entities of this state.

18 SECTION 2. Section 2171.052(e), Government Code, is 19 repealed.

20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
