AN ACT

relating to the prohibition of the use of certain colors on certain signs, signals, or markings.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 544.006(a), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:

(a) A person may not place, maintain, or display on or in view of a highway an unauthorized sign, signal, marking, or device that:

(1) imitates or resembles an official traffic-control device or railroad sign or signal;

(2) attempts to direct the movement of traffic; ~~or~~

(3) hides from view or hinders the effectiveness of an official traffic-control device or railroad sign or signal; or

(4) displays a green, red, or yellow light in a moving directional pattern except for signs marking railroad crossings.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect on September 1, 2003.
