Sections 801.361(a) and (b), Occupations Code, 10 11 are amended to read as follows: 12 (a) To the extent consistent with rules adopted by the Texas 13 Commission on Environmental Quality under Subsection (b), a [A] 14 veterinarian may dispose of the remains of an animal by burial or burning if: 15 (1) the burial or burning occurs in the county in which 16 the remains are discovered and on property owned by the 17 18 veterinarian; and (2) the veterinarian does not charge for the burning 19 or burial. 20 21 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, the Texas [Natural 22 Resource Conservation] Commission on Environmental Quality may not adopt a rule related to the disposal of animal remains under this 23 section unless the rule is developed in cooperation with and is 24

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
