4	SECTION 1. Section 61.001, Government Code, is amended by
5	amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (c-1) to read as
6	follows:
7	(c) The commissioners court of each county shall determine
8	annually the daily reimbursement of expenses for jurors. Except as
9	provided by Subsection (d), the reimbursement must be within the
10	minimum and maximum amounts prescribed by this section and paid out
11	of the jury fund of the county. The commissioners court may set
12	different daily reimbursements for:
13	(1) grand and petit jurors; or
14	(2) different petit jurors based on:
15	(A) whether a juror serves in a justice, county,
16	or district court; or
17	(B) any other reasonable criteria determined by
18	the commissioners court.
19	$\underline{(c-1)}$ In a specific case, the presiding judge, with the
20	agreement of the parties involved or their attorneys, may increase
21	the daily reimbursement for jurors in that case to an amount not to
22	exceed the maximum amount prescribed by this section. The
23	difference between the usual daily reimbursement and the
