- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 521.146, Transportation Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 521.146. APPLICATION FOR DUPLICATE LICENSE OR
- 9 CERTIFICATE. (a) If a driver's license or certificate issued under
- 10 this chapter is lost or destroyed, or there is a change in pertinent
- 11 information, the person to whom the license or certificate was
- issued may obtain a duplicate or corrected version.
- 13 (b) A person who moves from the address shown on the license
- 14 or certificate or changes the person's name must notify the
- 15 department of the change and apply for a duplicate license or
- certificate not later than the 30th day after the date on which the
- 17 change takes effect.
- 18 <u>(c)</u> An applicant for a corrected driver's license or
- 19 certificate must submit to the department the required fee,
- 20 accompanied by the required information that has changed with proof
- 21 satisfactory to the department that supports the change.
- (d) $[\frac{(c)}{(c)}]$ The department by rule may provide that the holder
- 23 of a driver's license or identification certificate issued by the
- 24 department may apply for the issuance of a duplicate license or

- 1 certificate by mail, by telephone, over the Internet, or by other
- 2 electronic means.
- 3 (e) (d) A rule adopted under Subsection (d) (d) may
- 4 prescribe eligibility standards for issuance of a duplicate
- 5 driver's license or identification certificate under this section.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 521.341, Transportation Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 521.341. REQUIREMENTS FOR AUTOMATIC LICENSE
- 9 SUSPENSION. Except as provided by Sections 521.344(d)-(i), a
- 10 license is automatically suspended on final conviction of the
- 11 license holder of:
- 12 (1) an offense under Section 19.05, Penal Code,
- 13 committed as a result of the holder's criminally negligent
- 14 operation of a motor vehicle;
- 15 (2) an offense under Section 38.04, Penal Code, that
- 16 was committed while operating a motor vehicle;
- 17 (3) an offense under Section 49.04 or 49.08, Penal
- 18 Code;
- 19 (4) an offense under Section 49.07, Penal Code, if the
- 20 person used a motor vehicle in the commission of the offense;
- 21 (5) an offense punishable as a felony under the motor
- vehicle laws of this state;
- 23 (6) an offense under Section 550.021; or
- 24 (7) an offense under Section 521.451 or 521.453.
- 25 SECTION 3. Section 601.162(b), Transportation Code, is
- 26 amended to read as follows:
- 27 (b) If a suspension is terminated under Subsection

- 1 (a)(3)(C), on notice of a default in the payment of an installment
- 2 under the agreement, the department shall promptly suspend the
- 3 driver's license and vehicle registration or nonresident's
- 4 operating privilege of the person defaulting. A suspension under
- 5 this subsection continues until:
- 6 (1) the person deposits and maintains security in
- 7 accordance with Section 601.153 in an amount determined by the
- 8 department at the time of suspension under this subsection and
- 9 files evidence of financial responsibility in accordance with
- 10 Section 601.153; or
- 11 (2) the second anniversary of the date security was
- 12 required [deposited] under Subdivision (1) if, during that period,
- 13 an action on the agreement has not been instituted in a court in
- 14 this state.
- SECTION 4. Section 601.340(a), Transportation Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) or (c), the
- 18 department shall suspend the registration of each motor vehicle
- 19 registered in the name of a person if the department:
- 20 (1) under any state law, other than Section
- 521.341(7) [521.341(6)], suspends or revokes the person's driver's
- license on receipt of a record of a conviction or a forfeiture of
- 23 bail; or
- 24 (2) receives a record of a guilty plea of the person
- 25 entered for an offense for which the department would be required to
- suspend the driver's license of a person convicted of the offense.
- 27 SECTION 5. Sections 521.054, 521.102, and 521.423,

- 2 as added by Chapter 1156, Acts of the 75th Legislature, Regular
- 3 Session, 1997, are repealed.
- 4 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
