- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 91.027(a) and (b), Human Resources
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) To the extent that funds are available under Sections
- 8 521.421(f) and 521.422(b), Transportation Code, the [The]
- 9 commission shall [develop a Blindness Education, Screening, and
- 10 Treatment Program to provide:
- 11 (1) blindness prevention education and [to provide]
- 12 screening and treatment to prevent blindness for residents who are
- 13 not covered under an adequate health benefit plan; and
- 14 (2) transition services to blind disabled individuals
- 15 eligible for vocational rehabilitation services under Section
- 16 91.052.
- 17 (b) [The commission shall implement the program only to the
- 18 extent that funds are available under Section 521.421(f),
- 19 Transportation Code. The program established under this section
- 20 shall include:
- 21 (1) public education about blindness and other eye
- 22 conditions;
- 23 (2) screenings and eye examinations to identify
- conditions that may cause blindness; [and]

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- 1 (3) treatment procedures necessary to prevent
- 2 blindness; and
- 3 (4) transition services.
- 4 SECTION 2. The section heading for Section 91.027, Human
- 5 Resources Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 91.027. BLINDNESS EDUCATION, SCREENING, [AND]
- 7 TREATMENT, AND TRANSITION SERVICES [PROGRAM].
- 8 SECTION 3. Section 521.421(f), Transportation Code, as
- 9 added by Chapter 510, Acts of the 75th Legislature, Regular
- 10 Session, 1997, is amended to read as follows:
- 11 (f) The department shall collect an additional fee of \$1 for
- 12 the issuance or renewal of a license to fund the program [Blindness
- 13 Education, Screening, and Treatment Program] established under
- 14 Section 91.027, Human Resources Code, if the person applying for or
- 15 renewing a license opts to pay the additional fee.
- SECTION 4. Section 521.422(b), Transportation Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 (b) The department shall collect an additional fee of \$1 for
- 19 the issuance or renewal of a personal identification card to fund
- 20 the program [Blindness Education, Screening, and Treatment
- 21 Program] established under Section 91.027, Human Resources Code, if
- the person applying for or renewing a personal identification card
- opts to pay the additional fee.
- 24 SECTION 5. The Texas Commission for the Blind shall
- 25 establish the consolidated program under Section 91.027, Human
- 26 Resources Code, as amended by this Act, not later than the 90th day
- 27 after the effective date of this Act.

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SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
