## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the annexation of additional territory and the
3	composition of the port commission of the Port of Corpus Christi
4	Authority of Nueces County, Texas.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Chapter 397, Acts of the 68th Legislature,
7	Regular Session, 1973, are amended to read as follows:
8	Sec. 1. COMPOSITION OF PORT COMMISSION; REQUIREMENTS. The
9	port commission of the Port of Corpus Christi Authority of Nueces
10	County, Texas is composed of seven members.
11	Sec 1A. FULL FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE. A port
12	commissioner must file an annual financial disclosure report, the
13	same form as that required by law for the District Court Judges.
14	Sec. 1B. DISCLOSURE OF VENDOR RELATIONSHIP. (a) The
15	port Commission of the Port of Corpus Christi Authority of Nueces
16	County, Texas shall prescribe a conflicts disclosure statement for
17	vendors and port commissioners.
18	(b) A port commissioner shall disclose on the
19	conflicts disclosure statement any employment or other business
20	relationship the commissioner has with a vendor who participates,
21	as a bidder or in another manner, in the purchasing procedures used
22	by the Authority, if that relationship results in the

commissioner's receipt of taxable income from the vendor. The

commissioner must include on the statement a description of the

- 1 nature and extent of the relationship.
- 2 <u>c) The port commissioner must file the disclosure</u>
- 3 statement with the clerk of the county not later than the 10th day
- 4 after the date the commissioner becomes aware of the vendor's
- 5 participation, by the submission of a bid or in another manner, in
- 6 the purchasing procedures of the Authority.
- 7 (d) A vendor described by Subsection (b) shall file a
- 8 conflicts disclosure statement with the clerk of the county not
- 9 later than the 10th day after the vendor:
- 10 <u>(1) begins contract discussions or negotiations</u>
- 11 with the Authority; or
- 12 (2) forwards an application, response to a
- 13 request for proposal, correspondence, or other writings related to
- 14 an agreement or potential agreement with the Authority.
- (e) A vendor shall file an updated conflicts
- 16 <u>disclosure statement with the clerk of the county:</u>
- 17 (1) on September 1 of each year; and
- 18 (2) after each event that would make a statement
- in the conflicts disclosure statement incomplete or inaccurate.
- 20 Sec. 2. APPOINTMENT OF PORT COMMISSIONERS;
- 21 **ELICIBILITY** ANNEXATION OF SAN PATRICIO COUNTY INTO THE PORT OF
- 22 CORPUS CHRISTI AUTHORITY.
- 23 (a) The Commissioners Court of Nueces County shall
- 24 appoint <del>four</del> three members to the port commission, <del>and</del> the City
- 25 Council of Corpus Christi shall appoint three members to the port
- 26 commission and the Commissioners Court of San Patricio County shall
- 27 appoint one member to the port commission. The appointment of a port

- 1 commissioner by the Commissioners Court of San Patricio County has
- 2 the effect of annexing the territory of San Patricio County into the
- 3 Port of Corpus Christi Authority.
- 4 (b) A person must have been a resident of Nueces County
- 5 for at least six months to be eligible for appointment to the port
- 6 commission.
- 7 Sec. 3. TERMS OF OFFICE. (a) The port commissioners
- 8 shall serve staggered three-year two-year terms.
- 9 (b) A person may not serve more than  $\frac{\text{two}}{\text{tot}}$  full
- 10 terms as port commissioner.
- 11 Sec. 4. TERMINATION OF CURRENT NUECES COUNTY
- 12 COMMISSIONERS; APPOINTMENT OF NEW NUECES COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND
- 13 NEW SAN PATRICIO COUNTY COMMISSIONER. (a) The terms of the current
- 14 port commissioners appointed by the Commissioners Court of Nueces
- County shall expire on September 1, 2003. The Commissioners Court
- of Nueces County shall make new appointments to the port commission
- on September 1, 2003. In making its new appointments to the port
- 18 commission, the Commissioners Court of Nueces County shall appoint:
- 19 (1) two port commissioners to terms that expire
- 20 <u>September 1, 2006; and</u>
- 21 (2) one port commissioner to a term that expires
- 22 September 1, 2005.
- (b) In making its new appointment to the port
- 24 commission, the Commissioners Court of San Patricio County shall
- appoint one commissioner to a term that expires September 1, 2005.
- 26 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect on September 1, 2003.
