- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 617.002, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 617.002. COLLECTIVE BARGAINING BY STATE [PUBLIC]
- 8 EMPLOYEES PROHIBITED. (a) An official of the state [or of a
- 9 political subdivision of the state] may not enter into a collective
- 10 bargaining contract with a labor organization regarding wages,
- 11 hours, or conditions of employment of public employees.
- 12 (b) A contract entered into in violation of Subsection (a)
- is void.
- 14 (c) An official of the state [or of a political subdivision
- 15 of the state] may not recognize a labor organization as the
- 16 bargaining agent for a group of public employees.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
