3 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only 4 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of 5 this Act. A cause of action that accrues before the effective date 6 of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before that 7 date, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
