7	the application of a pit and fissure sealant to a dental assistant
8	if the dentist is a Medicaid provider <u>or the dentist practices in an</u>
9	area determined to be underserved by the Texas Department of
10	Health. Cleansing of the occlusal and smooth surfaces of the teeth
11	by a dental assistant is allowed immediately prior to and for the
12	sole purpose of preparing the tooth area for the placement of pit
13	and fissure sealants or orthodontic bonding resin, and shall not be
14	billed as a prophylaxis.
15	SECTION 2. Section 265.003(b), Occupations Code, is amended
16	to read as follows:
17	(b) A dental assistant may apply a pit and fissure sealant
18	under Subsection (a) only if:
19	(1) the assistant is certified to apply a pit and
20	fissure sealant under Section 265.004; and
21	(2) the dentist described by Subsection (a):
22	(A) is a Medicaid provider; or
23	(B) practices in an area determined to be
24	underserved by the Texas Department of Health.

1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
