15	SECTION 2. Section 265.003(b), Occupations Code, is amended

- fissure sealant under Section 265.004; and 20
- 21 (2) the dentist described by Subsection (a):

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
