- 5 SECTION 1. Section 40.062, Human Resources Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 40.062. EXEMPTION FROM CERTAIN COSTS AND FEES. The
- 8 department is not required to pay any cost or fee otherwise imposed
- 9 for court proceedings or other services, including a:
- 10 (1) filing fee or fee for issuance or service of
- 11 process imposed by Section 110.002, Family Code, or by Section
- 12 51.317, 51.318(b)(2), or 51.319, Government Code;
- 13 (2) transfer fee imposed by Section 110.002 or
- 14 110.005, Family Code;
- 15 (3) court reporter fee imposed by Section 51.601,
- 16 Government Code;
- 17 (4) judicial fund fee imposed by Sections 51.701 and
- 18 51.702, Government Code;
- 19 (5) judge's fee imposed by Section 25.0008 or 25.0029,
- 20 Government Code; [or]
- 21 (6) cost or security fee imposed by Section 12 or 622,
- 22 Probate Code; or
- 23 (7) fee imposed by a county officer under Section
- 24 118.011 or 118.052, Local Government Code.

1 SECTION 2. Section 40.062, Human Resources Code, as amended 2 by this Act, applies only to the payment of a fee under Section 118.011 or 118.052, Local Government Code, for a service requested3 4 or action filed on or after September 1, 2003. The payment of a fee for a service requested or action filed before September 1, 2003, is 5 governed by the law in effect on the date the service is requested 6 or the action is filed, and the former law is continued in effect 7 8 for that purpose.

9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
