- 2 relating to premium rates for certain small employer health benefit

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Articles 26.32(a) and (c), Insurance Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The premium rates for a small employer health benefit
- 8 plan with an enrollment of at least six eligible employees are
- 9 subject to this article.
- 10 (c) For a class of business, the premium rates charged
- 11 during a rating period to small employers with similar case
- 12 characteristics for the same or similar coverage, or the rates that
- 13 could be charged to those employers under the rating system for that
- 14 class of business, may not vary from the index rate by more than 43
- 15 $\left[\frac{25}{2}\right]$ percent.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and
- 17 applies only to a small employer health benefit plan that is
- 18 delivered or issued for delivery on or after January 1, 2004. A
- 19 small employer health benefit plan that is delivered or issued for
- 20 delivery before January 1, 2004, is governed by the law as it
- 21 existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that
- 22 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
