- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 502.102, Transportation 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) Each Monday, a county assessor-collector shall credit 8 to the county road and bridge fund an amount equal to the net 9 collections made during the preceding week until the amount so 10 credited for the calendar year equals the total of:
- 11 (1) \$60,000;

- 12 (2) \$350 for each mile of county road maintained by the 13 county, according to the most recent information available from the 14 department, not to exceed 500 miles;
- 15 (3) an amount equal to five percent of the tax and 16 penalties collected by the assessor-collector under Chapter 152, 17 Tax Code, in the preceding calendar year, not to exceed the amount 18 credited under this subdivision during calendar year 2002; and
- 19 (4) an amount equal to five percent of the tax and 20 penalties collected by the comptroller under Section 152.047, Tax 21 Code, in the preceding calendar year, not to exceed the amount 22 credited under this subdivision during calendar year 2002.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
