## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the amount of financial assistance a student may
- 3 receive under the TEXAS grant and tuition equalization grant
- 4 programs.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 56.307(h), Education Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (h) The total amount of grants that a student may receive in
- 9 an academic year under this subchapter and under Section 61.221 may
- 10 not exceed the total amount of tuition and required fees charged to
- 11 the student for the academic periods for which one or more of the
- 12 grants were awarded [maximum amount authorized under Section
- 13  $\frac{61.227}{1}$ .
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies
- 15 beginning with the 2003-2004 academic year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
