## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the authority of veterinarians to form a professional
- 3 association.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2(A), Texas Professional Association Act
- 6 (Article 1528f, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 (A) Formation. Any one or more persons duly licensed to
- 9 practice a profession, including podiatry, dentistry, [or]
- 10 optometry, [or] therapeutic optometry, [or] chiropractic, or
- 11 veterinary medicine, under the laws of this state may, by complying
- 12 with this Act, form a professional association, as distinguished
- 13 from either a partnership or a corporation, by associating
- 14 themselves for the purpose of performing professional services and
- 15 dividing the gains therefrom as stated in articles of association
- or bylaws.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
