MANDATORY DISCLOSURE REQUIREMENTS (b) The insurer shall provide to a current or prospective group 7 contract holder or current or prospective insured on request an 8 accurate written or electronic description of the terms and 9 conditions of the policy to allow the current or prospective group 10 11 contract holder or current or prospective insured to make 12 comparisons and informed decisions before selecting among health care plans. The written or electronic description must be in a 13 14 readable and understandable format as prescribed by the commissioner and must include a current list of preferred 15 providers. The insurer may provide its handbook to satisfy this 16 requirement provided the handbook's content is substantively 17 similar to and achieves the same level of disclosure as the written 18 or electronic description prescribed by the commissioner and the 19 20 current list of physicians and health care providers is provided. 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1. 2003.

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
