16	(n) The exception provided by Subsection (a) applies to a
17	retiree employed in positions under Subsections (a)(1) and (a)(2)
18	in the same month only if the total number of days that the retiree
19	works in those positions in that month do not exceed the number of
20	days per month for work on a one-half-time basis.
21	(o) The exception provided by Subsection (a) applies to a
22	disability retiree employed in positions under Subsections (a)(1)
23	and (a)(4) in the same month only if the total number of days that
24	the disability retiree works in those positions in that month do not

1 exceed the number of days per month for work on a one-half-time
2 basis.

3 SECTION 2. Section 824.602, Government Code, as amended by 4 this Act, applies beginning with the 2003-2004 school year.

5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
