L1	(b) The governor, with the assistance of the classification
L2	officer in the office of the state auditor, shall conduct agency
L3	workforce efficiency reviews.
L4	(c) An agency workforce efficiency review includes:
L5	(1) a review of agency processes to determine
L6	appropriate levels of staffing;
L7	(2) recommendations to the agency on how to improve
L8	agency processes; and
L9	(3) if the governor determines, after review, that the
20	agency is overstaffed:
21	(A) a recommendation on the appropriate number of
22	full-time employees the agency should employ; and
23	(B) identification of appropriate budget
24	reductions in the appropriations to the agency for the next

- 2 <u>(d) The classification officer in the office of the state</u>
- 3 <u>auditor shall provide the governor with workforce statistics and</u>
