2	relating to a study of flood control in certain counties.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. FLOOD CONTROL INTERIM STUDY
5	(a) The Texas House of Representatives shall conduct a study
6	of:
7	(1) methods of flood control in Texas;
8	(2) local, state and federal flood control activities;
9	and
10	(3) governmental cooperation between local entities;
11	(4) improved governmental mechanisms to prioritize
12	and streamline flood control efforts;
13	(5) the need for a regional system of flood control;
14	(5) the potential of flood control districts to
15	<pre>improve flood control efforts;</pre>
16	SECTION 2: AREAS OF STUDY. The study shall include a county
17	with a population not less than 1,300,000 and not more than
18	1,400,000, according to the most recent federal decennial census.
19	SECTION 3: A report on the study and recommendation shall be
20	delivered to the lieutenant governor and the speaker of the house of
21	representatives no later than November 1, 2004.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
