- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 481.004, Government Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 Section 481.004. Governing Board
- 7 (a) The governing board is composed of five [nine] public
- 8 members appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the
- 9 senate, which members shall be appointed to give geographical
- 10 representation on the governing board to all regions of the state.
- 11 (b) Members of the governing board serve for six-year terms
- 12 with the terms of three members expiring February 1 of each
- 13 odd-numbered year.
- 14 (c) Appointments to the governing board shall be made
- 15 without regard to the race, color, handicap, sex, religion, age, or
- 16 national origin of the appointees.
- 17 (d) In making appointments under this section, the governor
- 18 shall attempt to include members of different minority groups
- 19 including females, African Americans, Hispanic Americans, Native
- 20 Americans, Asian Americans, and persons who are disabled.
- (e) At least one member of the governing board must [be a
- 22 resident of a county with a population of less than 30,000, at least
- 23 one other member must have experience in international trade, at
- 24 $\frac{\text{least one other member must}}{\text{least one other member must}}$ have experience in tourism[, and at

- 1 least one other member must be an economic development
- 2 <u>practitioner</u>].
- 3 SECTION 2. This bill takes effect September 1, 2003.
